

# TGJ, Inc., Board and Editors' Meeting Agenda For July 19-20, 2005

## Organizational Items:

1. Joseph Meador: does he and should he continue to be on the board, is he an asset or a liability to *TGJ*?
2. We need to replace Noah Hackworth and Eddie Whitten on the "Arbitration Committee" as soon as possible.

## Publication Items:

3. A "new" look, "new" page format, "new" departments, and "new" features in *TGJ*.
4. A greater variety of writers in *TGJ*.
5. Advertising *TGJ* bookstore and/or the books for sale by *TGJ*.
6. The redundant items in *TGJ* concerning *TGJ* matters (ex: "Volunteer Agents," "Dear Subscriber," "Reprints Encouraged," etc.).
7. Subscription and advertising rates (increase or not).
8. Problems with renewal notification of subscribers.

## Bookstore Items:

9. Should *TGJ* continue to market Apologetic Press books, as long as Dave Miller is associated with Apologetic Press (whether or not he is its Director) and as long as the other Apologetic Press staffers, Board Members, and other immediate Apologetic Press associates (e.g., Frank Chesser, the preacher where most Apologetic Press staffers are members) continue to ignore accusations against him and/or defend him?
10. Going "online" with *TGJ* bookstore.
11. Accepting credit cards for books and subscriptions
12. Publication and distribution of a catalog of the books sold by *TGJ*.

## Other Items:

13. Whether or not to continue *TGJ* Lectures.
14. Long term plans:
  - a. Recognizing that the present location is temporary.
  - b. Do we want a permanent location, staff, etc.
  - c. Where should we look to be located, cost, time to accomplish, how to do it, etc.
  - d. Do we want to stop with just what we doing now and just work on trying to improve or do we wish to consider other areas?

15. The Marriage, Divorce, Remarriage, issue that is stirring in the brotherhood.
  - a. Not allowing it to enter into the pages of *TGJ*.
  - b. The relationship between *TGJ* and Schertz congregation:
    - i. Through the ASL book and thus the ASL itself with the Schertz congregation if Stan Crowley is still the preacher at Schertz by ASL time (whether or not he speaks or has a chapter in the book).
    - ii. If the Schertz elders allow Stan Crowley (who has been identified as a false teacher on MDR) to speak on ASL, how will this affect *TGJ*'s relationship with ASL and the Schertz Congregation?
      - (a) Should *TGJ* publish the ASL book?
      - (b) Should *TGJ* sell any books at ASL?
      - (c) Should *TGJ* dissociate itself from the Schertz Congregation?
    - iii. If Stan Crowley is not allowed to speak at ASL, but is still the preacher at Schertz by ASL time, would/should this affect any of the other matters?
    - iv. Should Stan Crowley be allowed to have a chapter in the ASL/*TGJ* book, even if he is not speaking at ASL?
16. Establishing an annual "one or two day" Board meeting.
